

psyIT Wireless Network Guide

Introduction

psyIT is glad to offer you an expanding network of wireless coverage. Areas currently covered include New PI (Building 5), Auditoriums, and Lobbies. Any portable device that has a MAC address may be registered for use on the wireless network. This includes notebook computers, cellular phones, and PDAs. Even if you have previously used your notebook computer on the psyIT network you need to register again for wireless access. Phones and PDAs will need be registered as well.

Usage Policies

All standard usage policies that apply to the wired network (see <http://psyit.nyspi.org/policies.html>) also apply to the wireless network. In addition, we ask that you comply with the following policies specific to wireless access. Compliance will help everyone have an available and speedy wireless connection.

1. Please limit the use of the wireless network to portable devices that are normally mobile. If you regularly use a notebook computer at your desk and are within easy reach of a network jack we ask that you use the wired network.
2. Some cellular phones are able to utilize a wireless signal to carry calls in addition to their standard cellular network connection. We ask that you disable this feature when using the psyIT wireless network.

We hope you enjoy this new service and use it in a manner that is considerate to others.
